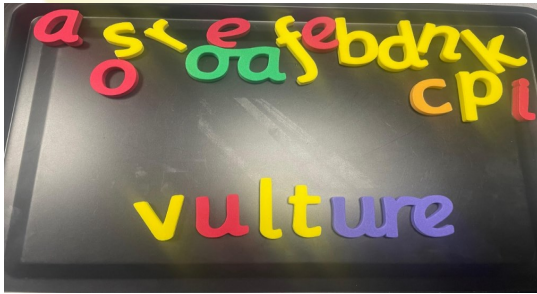

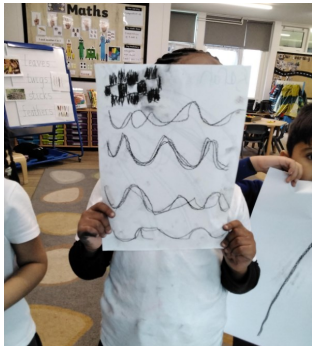


In the Spotlight
